Searching for Past Articles in the Poughkeepsie Journal (1999-present)

If a patron is looking for an article from the Poughkeepsie Journal newspaper that was published between 1999 and today, these are available by searching the 'archives' section of the website to obtain the citation, and then requesting a photocopy of the article from the Central Library Reference Department. We prefer to send articles through the MHLS delivery system, but can also mail them. Images and text can be badly degraded by faxing, so this is discouraged. In-library copies of microfilm cost .20 per page.

The articles can also be purchased online for \$3.95each, paid to the Poughkeepsie Journal, if instant delivery is needed.

The Poughkeepsie Public Library District maintains physical archives of the newspaper on microfilm dating back to 1785 with some gaps. Holdings are complete, by and large, from 1800 to present, though there is not an index to the older papers.
