For Scholarship Applicants

Scholarship Applications for the 2014-2015 academic year will be available in early 2014.

The Community Foundation administers scholarship funds established by individuals, families, corporations and organizations to assist high school and other students in pursuit of educational opportunities. These awards are charitable grants that the recipient is not required to repay. Scholarships may be used for legitimate educational expenses such as tuition, fees, books and room and board.

Many of the Foundation's scholarship use a [Common Application](#). It will provide you with application procedures, other scholarship resources and a list of funds that utilize the common application.

The Community Foundation supports individuals seeking funding for higher educational opportunities by administering a variety of scholarship funds for area residents.
