Notice of Trustee Election

Library District Election – November 8, 2016

Town of Poughkeepsie - 1 Trustee – 5 Year Term (1/1/2014 - 12/31/2018)
(Candidates for this position must live in the Town of Poughkeepsie)

Town of Poughkeepsie - 2 Trustees – Unexpired Terms (1/1/2017 - 12/31/2019)
(Candidates for this position must live in the Town of Poughkeepsie)

Town of Poughkeepsie - 1 Trustee – Unexpired Term (1/1/2017 - 12/31/2020)
(Candidates for this position must live in the Town of Poughkeepsie)

City of Poughkeepsie - 1 Trustee – 5 Year Term (1/1/2017 - 12/31/2021)
(Candidates for this position must live in the City of Poughkeepsie)

City of Poughkeepsie - 1 Trustee – Unexpired Term (1/1/2017 - 12/31/2019)
(Candidates for this position must live in the City of Poughkeepsie)

Trustees of the Poughkeepsie Public Library District, which comprises both the City and the Town of Poughkeepsie, shall be elected by registered voters of their respective municipality.

Candidates must circulate a petition that must contain the name, address and PO address, if different, of candidate. Each petition shall contain the signatures, printed name, and address of a minimum of 25 registered voters of the municipality for which the candidate is nominated and date of signature. The petition shall state the term of office for the candidate. Petitions may circulate through Tuesday, August 23, 2016.

A petition may contain one or several pages. A witness attesting that the petition was signed in his presence by each of the persons whose signature appears thereon and that the person signing the petition represented himself to be such person shall sign each page of the petition. The witness shall sign each page under the penalty of perjury.

Each petition shall be filed with the Dutchess County Board of Elections from Tuesday, August 16 – Tuesday, August 23, 2016 between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

All proceedings in relation to the election for library trustees shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the New York State Election Law.

Petitions may be obtained at Adriance Memorial Library (93 Market Street) and at the Boardman Road Branch Library (141 Boardman Road) during hours of operation or from the Library District's web site at www.poklib.org.
