Language Learning Websites & Apps

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Planning a trip abroad this Summer? Duolingo and Mango Languages are two great language learning resources in case you need a refresher on that high school Spanish!



Mango Languages- Mango Languages is available for free to any cardholder within the Mid-Hudson Library System. Mango Languages has 64 foreign language courses including: Spanish, English, French, Italian, German, Greek, Chinese, Japanese, or Russian. Mango Languages also offers English lessons in 17 languages and specialty courses to teach cultural differences. Learn a language the fun interactive way – all on your own schedule, at your own pace, and wherever you want. Stop in the middle of a lesson and sign back in at a later point, Mango will keep track of everything for you.



Mango is accessible from a web browser or an app (The Mango Languages app is available on Google Play, Amazon Apps, and the iTunes App Store).



Duolingo-Duolingo is a free language learning website and app (The app is available on iOS, Android and Windows 8 and 10 platforms) . The site and app offer 68 different language learning courses for 23 different languages. The site also offers a digital language proficiency assessment exam users can take to assess their skill level.
