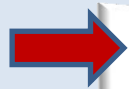
Get Creative!

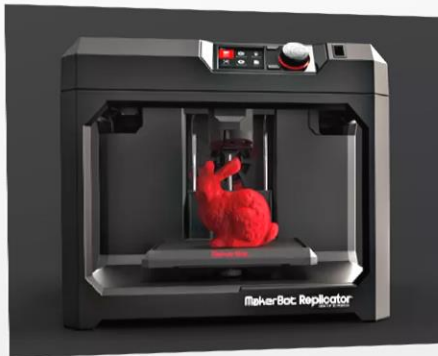

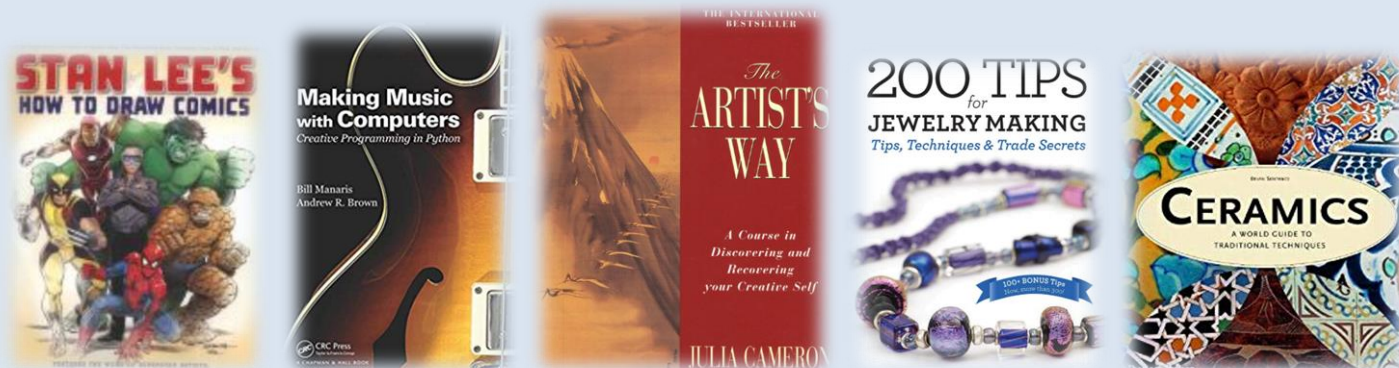
