If you earned \$66,000 or less in 2018, you are eligible to file your federal AND state taxes for free! Some free tax filing services offer only free federal filing or may charge extra for certain forms. [MyFreeTaxes.com](http://MyFreeTaxes.com), provided by the United Way, is the only free, national, online tax filing service that is provided by a non-profit.

[MyFreeTaxes.com](http://MyFreeTaxes.com) is powered by H&R Block premium software so filing is safe, secure, and guaranteed accurate. It is easy to use on your mobile device, tablet, or desktop!

## How it Works

Through our partnership with H&R Block, every household that earned up to \$66,000 in 2018 can file their federal and state tax returns for free. All you need to do is follow these steps:

### Create or log-into your free H&R Block Account

Always start from MyFreeTaxes. Once your account is created, you'll see a MyFreeTaxes logo on the top-left of your screen. This logo will be on every screen except your account creation page, and ensures you're filing with MyFreeTaxes and not one of H&R Block's paid products.

### Use H&R Block's online application to complete your tax return

You don't need to complete your return all at once—you can save your spot in the process and return to it when you have time. We recommend bookmarking the page or returning to it via MyFreeTaxes.com. Don't forget to securely save your username and password!
