Public Comment at Public Meetings

A comment period will be available at the beginning of each public meeting, so that Library District residents, staff, and other interested parties may speak to issues and make inquiries concerning agenda items and/or items concerning the Library District. Generally, remarks are to be limited to three minutes and each speaker to one appearance. Questions directed to the Board will be noted and responded to within one week, if possible.

Those wishing to suggest agenda items should contact Board members or the Library Director.

If more citizens wish to comment than time allows, an additional period will be available at the end of the business meeting. The presiding officer shall make all decisions regarding recognition and time allowed to each speaker.
